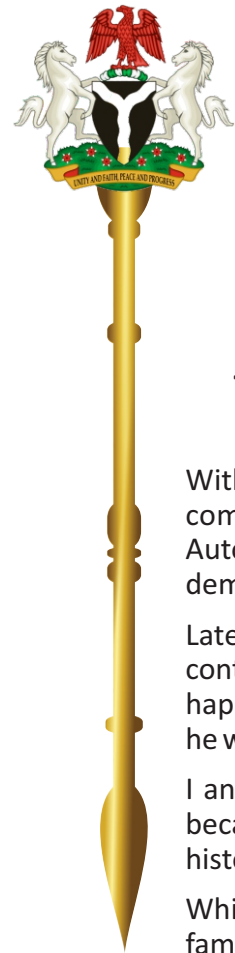
Late Eze Ngozi Anyaehie lived a very humble life, he was a king-servant who served both the old and the young alike without discrimination. A Hero indeed is gone.
