

UMU-NWUGHA KINDRED IDENTIFIES WITH OUR DEPARTED SON & EZE NNANANO NKWERRE AUTONOMOUS COMMUNITY (HRH EZE NGOZI GABRIEL HENDRIX ANYAEHIE)

Our son (HRH, Eze Ngozi Anyaehie) who reigned after the Eze-elect (Barr. C.S. Nwosu) became the 1st inaugurated Eze of Nnanano, who was born in 1947 and died in 2023, after 76years sojourn on planet earth.

Our kindred, (Umu-nwugha) is no less bereaved than other kindreds or villages in Nnanano Nkwerre Autonomous Community.

On behalf of Ndi Nze, Elders, men, women and youths of this kindred we wish to express our deepest concern and do sincerely commiserate with the family of Anyaehie-Nwagu over this great Iroko that has fallen in our midst over the untimely demise of our son and the Eze of the Community.

Our brother while alive was not only the Traditional Ruler of Nnanano but also occupied several prominent positions in Umu-nwugha, Nnenator, Nnanano and the larger Nkwerre both at home and in diaspora.

- (e)The patron of Nkwerre Ohu-ebe titled men.

(f)The Traditional Ruler of Nnanano Nkwerre Autonomous Community. G)The trustee & patron of Nkwerre Country Club.

(h)The Patron of Aba sports Club, Enyimba City.

(i)The one time elected Chairman of Aba North LGA, Abia State.

Time and Space may not allow us to express how deeply touched we are over the untimely death of our son, brother, Uncle and Father Eze Ngozi because we would greatly miss him and his wise counsel, his companionship, good judgement and decisions and more importantly his milk of human kindness as he regularly assists widows, widowers, orphans, Churches and the less-privilegeds, beyond our Kindred.

Within his short stint on the throne, he used his contacts to attract 300kVA Transformer to our village, 500kVA Transformer to another Sister village (Umunaga) and acquired 4 plots of land Fenced with Borehole for the establishment of Nnanano Civic Centre which would also house Permanent Obi-Nnanano and Eze's Palace. These dreams on the face value at the moment seems to have been caught short.

Oh death, where are your stings? And why now at the prime of your reign, but we shall be consoled only on the word of God that admonishes us not to mourn like the heathens who do not cast their trust and hope on the grace of God who can do all things through Christ that strengthens us.

By this Tribute we encourage Prince Chimdi and his Sisters, Princesses Amarachi and Nkeiru, to bear this great loss with equanimity, at the same time praying our entire Kindred and Nnanano Community to allow the agape love of God to dwell mightily amongst us, as we mourn with renewed hope and belief in the Almighty God.
